

BBQ Lighting Instructions!

1. Make sure all knobs are in the “OFF” position before hooking up propane tank
2. Hook up propane, turn valve on tank ‘slowly’ counter-clockwise to open
3. Push down the knob closet to the propane hose, and it to “HIGH”
4. Using a long-neck BBQ lighter, go through the hole on the side you are lighting, and spark the burner element. Flames should ignite immediately.
5. Once the first burner is lit, the other elements should ignite by simply turning the next corresponding knob to the “HIGH” position. If they do not ignite reach under the BBQ with the lighter and put a flame directly to the burner tube at the very beginning where it meets the pilot tube that runs through the entire BBQ. Don’t worry the flames will not shoot down towards your hand they will rise.
6. Now that all the burners are lit you may adjust heat on all elements to desired temperature

If BBQ does not light, or has a very low flame, the propane’s tank safety valve may have been triggered;

1. Turn all knobs to “OFF”
2. Turn the propane tank off, and unhook the hose
3. Reattach the hose
4. Repeat lighting instructions
